parking

The Oregon Convention Center provides a limited number of spaces in their underground parking garage. It can be accessed via First Avenue. In addition, there is street parking with coin-operated meters nearby. The OCC is easily accessible by utilizing public transportation. The Portland Streetcar Central Loop and TriMet Bus Line #6 both stop right outside the center on NE Martin Luther King (MLK) Blvd. The blue, red and green MAX light rail lines all stop at the OCC at the intersection of NE MLK Blvd. and NE Holladay Street.
